Sharing the Word of God

In May RMO traveled to Bosnia-Herzegovina with Health Care Ministries. We ministered with Pastor Carmelo and his wife, Ivon. He is in charge of the churches in the Bosnia area. The home church, called Evandeoska Crkva, is located in Mostar. When they found the Lord and the baptism of the Holy Spirit they were evicted from their Catholic church and asked never to come back. They continue to reach out to those that never smile due to the deep scars and hurts suffered in the war.

They rented a place and started a Pentecostal church. The church is ostracized by the Orthodox Croatians and the Muslim Bosniaks. For 12 years they have asked permission to build. They have purchased the property but need permission to build. They wait patiently, battling the bureaucracy, continuing to meet with the authorities and asking-and praying. The town school radiates the thinking with one floor for the Bosniaks, one floor for the Croatians, and one for a small university.

I was asked to share the word in the Sunday am service. When I finished one lady came up and said "I want the peace you have". So I shared with her (via the interpreter) on Romans and the prayer language God gives us. I started praying and it just burst out of her, she could not stop the prayer language coming out of her mouth. She had a big smile. That lady has 8 children. She left with a new way to pray and a new joy in her heart.

We did medical and dental clinics. The dental clinics were always full.

She has one daughter and she helped us the whole time we were there with food, tea, etc. She would talk to us and I never once saw her smile. A broken heart is mended.
